Course Description:

This course provides for students who already have a basic knowledge of spoken Hebrew as well as grammatical structures with a more in-depth study of the language.

Specific attention is applied to verb conjugation, noun forms and syntactic structure of modern Hebrew.

Students will learn to understand and produce texts in modern Hebrew through exposure to literature, poetry, and everyday conversations. Each lesson emphasizes all four skills (comprehension, conversation, reading and writing) so that students will feel comfortable to use their skills.

Learning Outcomes:

Oral Communication - understand main ideas in discussions on a variety of topics as well as expand and effectively use precise and varied vocabulary

Reading Comprehension - understand various Hebrew text

Written Expression - produce narrative and descriptive writing
