Course Description:

An intermediate level course in which all aspects of language skills are covered with emphasis on the development of communicative skills. Intended for students who have completed a lower intermediate level such as JPN 2250 or JPN2260, or have equivalent knowledge. Successful completion of JPN3350 prepares for JPN4450.

Learning Outcomes:

Acquire more advanced communicative skills (speech, listening, reading, and writing) of modern Japanese, with a particular emphasis on the spoken language.

Acquire knowledge about Japanese culture through verbal communication and its mannerisms.

Acquire and manipulate linguistic signs for communication.

Prepare for intermediate level Japanese (e.g. JPN4450).

Increase and apply disciplinary knowledge, and develop transferable skills through experiential learning.
