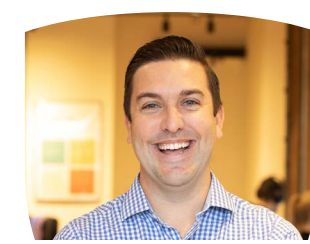

Huron's internship program takes a personalized approach to pair you with paid internships that align with your interests, strengths, and career goals. You can explore a variety of fields and industries – right from your first year. We take a proactive approach, working closely with you to identify your goals, and then support you to secure an appropriate paid internship or work experience.

This approach ensures that you are gaining valuable work experience during your studies in fields that you are passionate about, while developing the skills that prepare you for your future career.

CAREER INTERNSHIPS

STUDY

Take advantage of Huron's powerful Career Development Centre to build valuable Canadian work experience and access a consistent source of income through part-time jobs and paid internships. As an international student in Canada, you can work up to 20 hours per week off campus during the school year and full-time hours in the summer. There is no fixed limit of hours for part time work on campus.

WORK

Our partnership with Devant allows us to extend our personalized career development coaching for our students for up to one year after they graduate. As a student and recent alumni, you can virtually take part in career development events, 1:1 support, hiring expos, job search services, and more as you transition into the Canadian job market.



STAY

Canada leads the world in opportunities for international students after graduation through a Post Graduate Work Permit (PGWP) program of up to three years and pathways to Permanent Residency (PR) and Canadian citizenship beyond that. 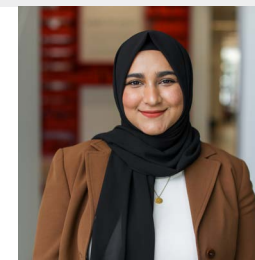

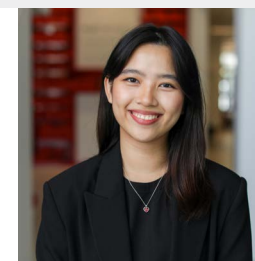

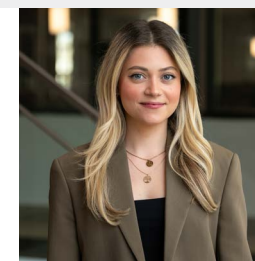
