

ADMISSION AND RESIDENCE DEPOSIT POLICY

March 2024

Incoming students are required to pay deposits to secure admission (if applicable) and apply for residence.

Domestic students: All incoming domestic students applying to residence must pay a non-refundable residence deposit of \$1,000. The deposit will be returned to the student at the end of the academic year. If room damage or lost keys are identified during the move-out inspection, the cost will be deducted from the deposit.

The residence deposit will only be refunded to students if Huron is not able to provide a space on campus. Refunds will be processed at the end of September.

International students: All incoming international students must pay a non-refundable admission deposit of \$3,000. The deposit includes \$1,000 for residence and \$2,000 for tuition. Off-campus students who pay the deposit will have the full \$3,000 applied to tuition. The residence deposit of \$1,000 will be returned to the student at the end of the academic year. If room damage or lost keys are identified during the move-out inspection, the cost will be deducted from the deposit.

The admission deposit will only be refunded in the event of a study permit rejection from the Government of Canada. Proof of study permit rejection is required to receive a refund. Refunds will be processed at the end of September.

Notes:

- If a student is placed on a waitlist and the student provides a written request (from UWO
 email) to be removed from the queue before a room has been offered to them, a refund
 will be issued.
- If a student defers enrollment, the deposit will be held and applied to future term.
