THE CHAPEL OF ST. JOHN THE EVANGELIST

General Use of Chapel:

- The Rector, as the representative of the Bishop of the Diocese of Huron, will have final authority on the use of the chapel.
- Primary consideration for use of the chapel will be given to the Rector of the Chapel at Huron University College, and the Faculty of Theology of Huron University College.
- Other than regularly scheduled worship, faculty and staff wishing to use the chapel must get confirmation in writing or by email from the chaplain.
- University of Western Ontario Chaplains may request use of the chapel for memorial services, baptisms, weddings and other special services. Consent is at the discretion of the Rector.
- Requests from others will be given serious consideration if they have connections to Huron University College, the University of Western Ontario or the Diocese of Huron.
- Situations other than those listed above will be considered and agreed to at the discretion of the Rector in consultation with the Bishop of the Diocese of Huron.

Weddings:

- All weddings must be arranged with the Rector of the chapel. Unless there is a sufficient cause to the contrary, the Rector of the Chapel will officiate at all weddings, funerals and memorial services in the Chapel.
- A policy has been put in place (see Chapel Weddings) that clearly sets out who may be married in the chapel:
 - any present or former faculty member, staff member, student or resident of Huron University College;
 - a regular attending member of the Chapel worship community;
 - children of active faculty members, staff members or students;
 - someone who has a pastoral relationship with the chaplain;
