This course introduces beginners to basic Arabic. Students will learn the Arabic alphabet, articulation of standard sounds, spelling conventions, essential grammar, and the principal vocabulary in Modern Standard Arabic. By the end of this course, students will be able to read and write simple sentences and to discuss rudimentary subjects. Antirequisite(s): Grade 12U Arabic. Arabic 1030, Arabic 1035, and Arabic 2050A/B Extra Information: 3 hours.

- Write simple grammatical sentences in Arabic and read short texts related to daily life.
- Answer simple questions and follow basic directions in Arabic.
- Communicate simple Arabic sentences with growing confidence and express personal thoughts in Arabic.
- Demonstrate an understand of Arabic culture through learned vocabulary.
