An introduction to Quranic Arabic for beginners with no previous knowledge of the Arabic language. Learn the script of the Qur'an, acquire core vocabulary necessary to understand short Quranic chapters, and dive into basic grammar of classical Arabic. Antirequisite(s): Islamic Studies 1070A/B. Extra Information: 3 hours. Note: Those with any Arabic language background must see Instructor to determine eligibility for course. Cross-listed with Islamic Studies 1070A/B.

Learning Outcomes:

- Pronounce the Arabic sounds proficiently and learn how make sentences.
- Identify the meaning of a variety of short Quranic verses studied in class.
- Demonstrate a mastery of basic Arabic grammar and apply it to short Quranic texts.
- Demonstrate their possession of a range of Quranic vocabulary together with their usage in Quranic texts.
- Reveal a basic knowledge and understanding of Quranic values.
