The focus is to expand Quranic vocabulary and to acquire a familiarity with more complex grammatical structures through studying Quranic texts. By the end of this course, students will have acquired the key principles of Quranic grammar. Antirequisite(s): Islamic Studies 2080A/B. Extra Information: 3 hours. Cross-listed with Islamic Studies 2080A/B.

Learning Outcomes:

- Progress in language skills (listening, speaking, reading, and writing) through their familiarity with Quranic verses.
- Apply to Quranic texts grammatical knowledge learned during the course.
- Discuss various aspects of Quranic values.
- Produce summaries of Quranic verses that include paraphrases of the main ideas.
- Use a range of Quranic vocabulary with a growing degree of complexity.
