- · expand students' Arabic vocabulary to help them comprehend a variety of Quranic texts
- · bring students to an advanced level of reading, writing, and comprehension skills
- enable students to write a short research paper pertinent to a Quranic topic
- · deepen the students' insights into the values embedded in the Quranic texts
