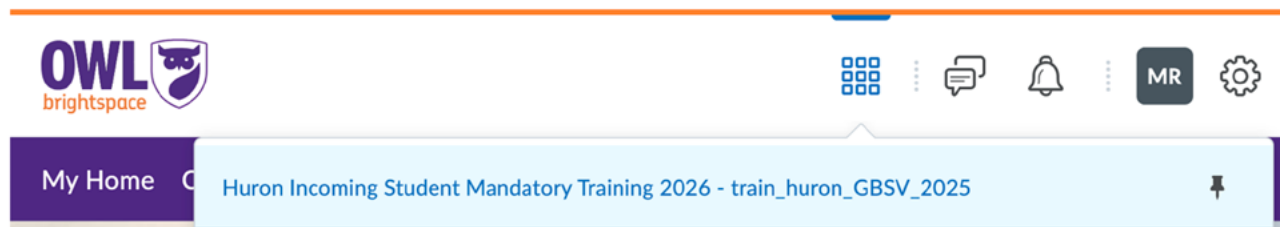
The module covers the following topics:

- Strategies to avoid misconduct (e.g., citation, collaboration, time management)
- Common scholastic offences (e.g., plagiarism, cheating, falsification)
- Consequences of violations and how to uphold integrity in your work

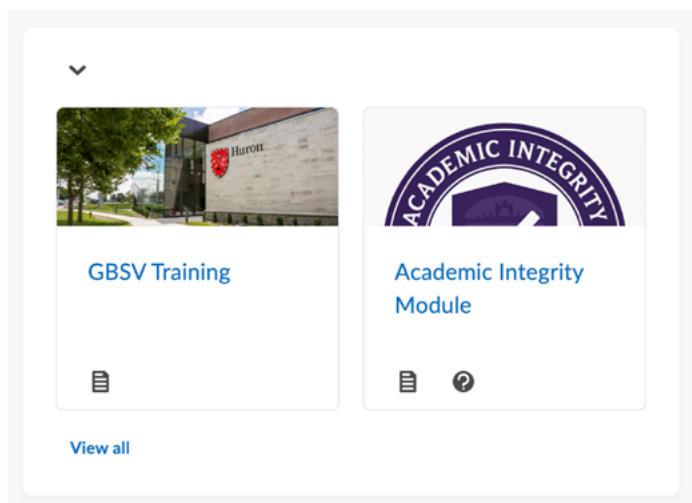

ACCESSING THE TRAINING

1. Head to [Brightspace](#).
2. Login using your Western credentials (your User ID is the portion before @uwo.ca in your UWO Email).

5. Complete and pass the quiz with a minimum score of 12/15.
