Course Description:

Advanced Accounting topics including international accounting and Canadian accounting treatment of intercorporate investments, business combinations, foreign currency translation and transactions, and accounting for not-for-profit organizations.

Accurately construct consolidated financial statements for a parent company and its subsidiaries

Summarize transactions between a parent and its subsidiaries and incorporate them in consolidated financial statements

Analyze mergers and acquisitions to determine that IFRS requirements have been followed

Contrast recent acquisitions to determine which should have most significant impact on future results for the acquirer and target company

Prepare appropriate entries to record foreign exchange transactions for a fair value hedge and a cash flow hedge and translate financial statements from a foreign currency into Canadian dollars using appropriate foreign exchange rates for foreign operations

Prepare journal entries for contributions received and disbursements made from not-for-profit organizations. Distinguish between Restricted Fund and Deferral accounting methods

Understand accounting for joint arrangements

Apply data analytics to a component of advanced accounting
