This course introduces and critically examines dominant approaches to understanding human interconnection at a global scale and provides an interdisciplinary overview of various trends attributed to globalization.

This course asks students to think critically about how global scale dynamics shape the context in which humans live their lives, solve problems, and seek change. Students are required to undertake research, critical analysis and present their work in written assignments.
