

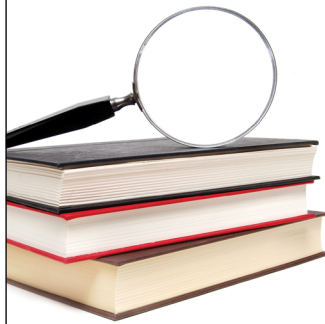


- Japanese Language and Culture

Applications are due the first week of December. You need to submit: an application form, two reference letters, and a 250 word statement about why you are a good candidate for the exchange program, a resume, and the \$25 application fee.

If Huron accepts you as an exchange participant, we will nominate you to the partner university. You will then be asked to fill out their application form.

Tuition is paid to Huron. You are responsible for living and travel expenses. Other Costs: Excursions, transport, books

Mandatory for all international students. The minimum coverage of your own insurance from Canada should be at least \$60,000 CAD.

The university will apply for the visa in Japan on your behalf after your submission of all the required documents.
