Students in our Global Gender Studies program examine the human-scale experiences of global integration, capitalism, and inequalities produced through colonialism and postcolonial development practices as they impact communities specifically based on gender, sexual difference, and sexual orientations. Students engage with the transformational forces of patriarchy in the world, and they gain training in feminist theory and analysis, while learning how anti-sexist and anti-heterosexist actions in global social innovation are put into action. In addition to taking courses offered in Global Social Innovation, students complement their CGSI studies with courses from the Department of Gender, Sexuality, and Women's Studies.

THE GLOBAL GENDER STUDIES PROGRAM EXAMINES:

- How persons are oriented to the world and one another on bases of gender, sex, and sexuality
- Ways in which power relations are established through acts of feminisation and masculinisation
- Feminism as a plurality of sources in global social innovation movements

- The politics of women's global solidarity movements
- Feminism in the works of decolonisation
- Bodily resistances to governance
- Genders of citizenship
