

### **Beyond the Classroom**

#### **CAREER INTERNSHIPS**

Get paid part-time experience during the school year or full-time in summer. These roles align with your interests and help build your resume with real-world value.

### ACADEMIC INTERNSHIPS

Earn while you learn. Take 4-16 months off between Year 3 and Year 4 for a full-time, for-credit, paid internship. Many students receive job offers after completion.



### **RESEARCH INTERNSHIPS**

Work with a Huron faculty member for support on a student research fellowship with funding up to \$1,500 or a paid research assistant opportunity.

The Auschwitz Jewish Center Fellows Program offers senior students a unique educational opportunity to learn about the Holocaust in the context of Poland's history and Jewish heritage. This summer fellowship includes travel in Poland for three weeks, during which time students visit Krakow, Warsaw, Łód´z, Treblinka, and O´swięcim (Auschwitz). There are also opportunities for study abroad exchanges in Israel, the United States, Europe, and beyond.
