Beyond the Classroom

Huron's AESL program partners with the community to integrate real-world experiences as a core component of each learner's degree. In a growing number of offerings, course content is directly linked to practical applications.

- AESL students have multiple opportunities to engage with animals and ethical businesses. An example has included TJ Stables, which is home to some of the world's only Ojibwe Spirit Horses.
- In the "Battle of the Brands," student teams champion realworld companies leading in animal, environmental, and social ethics. Winners are chosen by audience vote and celebrity judges from organizations like Animal Justice, Convertus Group, Odd Burger, and Nuts for Cheese.



CAREER INTERNSHIPS

Get paid part-time experience during the school year or full-time in summer. These roles align with your interests and help build your resume with real-world value.

ACADEMIC INTERNSHIPS

Earn while you learn. Take 4-16 months off between Year 3 and Year 4 for a full-time, for-credit, paid internship. Many students receive job offers after completion.



RESEARCH INTERNSHIPS

Work with a Huron faculty member for support on a student research fellowship with funding up to \$1,500 or a paid research assistant opportunity.

ENTREPRENEURIAL INTERNSHIPS

Get support to ideate, plan, and launch a new business. You'll get 1:1 coaching, access to funding, and other resources to set you up for success.
