Beyond the Classroom

In English & Cultural Studies, we are committed to experiential learning, which can involve everything from participating in the production of a theatrical performance to creating scholarly websites, doing standup comedy, producing creative work or travelling locally or abroad for research purposes.

CAREER INTERNSHIPS

Get paid part-time experience during the school year or full-time in summer. These roles align with your interests and help build your resume with real-world value.

ACADEMIC INTERNSHIPS

Earn while you learn. Take 4-16 months off between Year 3 and Year 4 for a full-time, for-credit, paid internship. Many students receive job offers after completion.
