Beyond the Classroom

All Japanese Studies & East Asia Studies students are encouraged to pursue their interests through independent research and share their work through conferences, showcases, and experiential learning opportunities. Examples include:

- Investigating real-world issues such as elderly care, low birth rates, and sustainable housing in Japan and Canada.
- Exploring culture and society through topics like high school baseball, LGBTQ+ representation in media, and global fashion trends.
- Presenting research in English or Japanese at CURL conferences, student showcases, and national associations.
- Engaging in experiential learning locally or abroad through travel, work-study, and volunteer initiatives.



CAREER INTERNSHIPS

Get paid part-time experience during the school year or full-time in summer. These roles align with your interests and help build your resume with real-world value.

ACADEMIC INTERNSHIPS

Earn while you learn. Take 4-16 months off between Year 3 and Year 4 for a full-time, for-credit, paid internship. Many students receive job offers after completion.



RESEARCH INTERNSHIPS

Work with a Huron faculty member for support on a student research fellowship with funding up to \$1,500 or a paid research assistant opportunity.
