Psychology is the scientific study of the brain and behaviour. It is a dynamic field of study that examines phenomena related to human development, motivations, perception and action, memory and cognition, thinking and intelligence, social relationships, and more.

The psychology program at Huron offers four B.A. modules of study, with a heavy focus on foundational research knowledge. Our emphasis on research skills development starts in the first year and continues throughout the program.

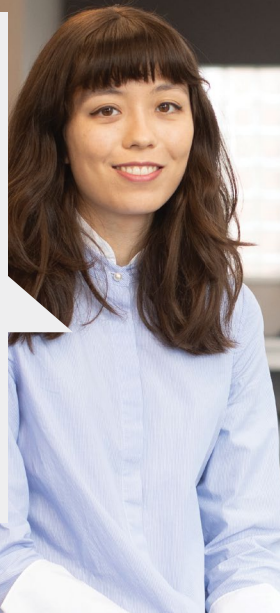

Beyond the Classroom

Learning at Huron doesn't stop at the classroom door. Our students expand their knowledge through real-world experiences that connect theory to practice, deepen cultural understanding, and build the skills needed to thrive in any career path. Examples include:

- The Trimentorship initiative provides academic mentoring and community building for first-year students, enabling them to work with senior students and faculty members in Psychology and to conduct original, student-driven research projects.
- Third-year students in the 3350G Adolescent Risk Development course collaborate with the Thames Valley School Board Safe Schools Team to create a Healthy Behaviours in an Online World workshop for high school students, and their families.

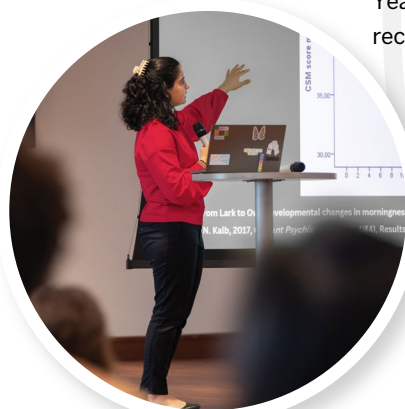


CAREER INTERNSHIPS

Get paid part-time experience during the school year or full-time in summer. These roles align with your interests and help build your resume with real-world value.

ACADEMIC INTERNSHIPS

Earn while you learn. Take 4–16 months off between Year 3 and Year 4 for a full-time, for-credit, paid internship. Many students receive job offers after completion.



RESEARCH INTERNSHIPS

Work with a Huron faculty member for support on a student research fellowship with funding up to \$1,500 or a paid research assistant opportunity.



ENTREPRENEURIAL INTERNSHIPS

Get support to ideate, plan, and launch a new business. You'll get 1:1 coaching, access to funding, and other resources to set you up for success.



Travel Study

Annually, Huron Psychology students have the opportunity to participate in Huron's Study Abroad program. Additionally, they can apply for and receive funding to take their research projects around the globe to conferences, unique facilities and to engage with international scholars.

Mitacs Globalink Research Awards: Huron is a Mitacs member and Psychology students have the opportunity to travel to Mitacs member countries to work on collaborative multinational research questions.
