Huron Ancillary Fees Descriptions

Student Buildings – This fee supports facilities/spaces that host student activities, shared student use spaces, multi-faith spaces as well as student service physical areas that enhance student experience.

Health and Wellness – This fee funds a wide range of health services both on-campus and remotely such as access to health professionals, student relevant resources, mental health and counselling.

Student Support & Case Management - This fee supports resources in the areas of gender-based violence and survivor support, student conduct support, general case management support and coordinated response from Huron on complex incidents.

Academic Support & Engagement – This fee supports the programs, resources and supports in the areas of academic skills and learning development, accessible education, and leadership, transition and enrichment programs including Learning and Writing Centre support services and academic counsellors.

Careers & Experience - This fee provides students with professional and career-related services such as career coaching, interview preparation, networking events, career information sessions, job boards, and job placement.

Community Safety Services - This fee supports programs and services that promote campus safety, emergency response, and prevention of gender-based violence.

Student Financial Aid – This fee supports enhanced financial aid services for students including extensive student loan application review and consultation to proactively clarify and correct errors, resulting in reduced application delays, processing times, and questions from OSAP, helping to ensure student funding is available at the start of the term.

WUSC - support student refugees in a safe and supportive environment in Canada. This unique program includes academic support to help with both the resettlement and university experience.

International Student Activity - This fee supports international learning and programs in support of international students including advising, events intercultural learning, immigration assistance etc. This fee supports students by providing opportunities to gain intercultural skills and experiences and by creating a diverse and welcoming Huron community.

International Welcome Week- This fee supports international students' orientation including access to programs, trips and services tailored to international students with the goal of helping students to smoothly transition to Canada and the Huron community.
