HURON UNIVERSITY - SENIOR CITIZEN BURSARY GUIDELINES/ELIGIBILITY

Canadian citizens or permanent residents of Ontario and who will be 60 years of age or older during the first month their classes commence may be eligible for a bursary subject to the following conditions:

ELIGIBILITY:

1. Applicant must be 60 years of age or older within the first month their study term commences.
2. Applicants must present proof of age when applying for the first time.
3. Applicants must be registered in Senate-approved courses or program. Special Student (Non-degree) programs are not eligible.
4. **Students can be awarded a maximum amount of \$1500 per fiscal year. The fiscal year is from May 1 to April 30. Audit courses are eligible.**
5. Applicant must initially satisfy Huron's entrance requirements for their chosen program or course(s).
6. Students are required to meet and maintain academic progression requirements.
7. Applications **must be submitted prior** to the start of classes and **prior** to tuition due date for the session in which the bursary is required.
8. Applicant must declare financial need.

NOTES:

- A. The value of the bursary is a maximum of \$1500 for the fiscal year **(May 1 to April 30)**. **The bursary will not cover ancillary/supplemental fees.** The bursary will not cover additional expenses such as books, sealing charges, late fees, late registration fees etc.
- B. Only students registered at Huron University and taking courses at Huron University are eligible. Students registered at affiliated University Colleges or main campus, please check with the Financial Aid Office at the respective University College for available funding.
- C. Admission to courses and programs is competitive. No assurance is given to students that they will be granted a place in such courses or programs.
- D. Summer courses are not eligible for this bursary.
- E. Applicants are responsible for submitting the bursary application **prior to the tuition fee deadline**. The bursary will not cover fees incurred from late or deferred charges.
- F. A reduction in course load/change in registration will correspondingly reduce value of bursary; if adding or dropping courses during the academic year, please notify our office **in writing** by email to financial.aid@huron.uwo.ca or theology@huron.uwo.ca.
- G. Students in receipt of external funding and/or other funding such as scholarships, awards or bursaries may have their Senior Bursary adjusted or cancelled.
- H. OSAP applicants will have the tuition costs on OSAP application adjusted depending on the value of the Senior Citizen Bursary.
- I. All correspondence will be sent to the applicant's UWO email account.
