STEP1. Nomination

Partner universities: Fill in a nomination form and submit it via Google Form during the above specified nomination period.

# STEP2. Online Application

Students: Submit application documents through the online application system during the above specified application period.

Refer to the Partner University Website for required application documents and application procedure.

## Courses (Non-degree)

# Japanese Course

Japanese Studies Center for International Students (Bekka)

Based on the Bekka curriculum, students will take classes of Japanese language and Japanese culture. Elective classes can be chosen from the Bekka timetable.

# English Course

Faculty of Global Engagement, Department of Global Studies

Students will take classes from about 30 selected classes of the Department of Global Studies.

Japanese language class is not available for this course.

Transcripts

KUFS will send transcripts to the partner universities via email after the end of the following dates. Spring Semester: After September 20th / Fall Semester: After March 20th.

The course cannot be changed once the application is accepted.

## **Entry Requirements**

GPA GPA of 2.5 or higher is preferred on a 4.0 scale

\*Other requirements except below are as per the agreement.

Language Proficiency

1. Japanese Course

- · Required to have studied the Japanese language for 150 hours or more.
- · To be able to read and write Hiragana and Katakana.

2. English Course

 To have the English language proficiency equivalent to TOEFL iBT score of 62 or IELTS score of 5.0 for students in non-English-speaking countries and regions.

# Requirements and COE

Unless you are a Japanese citizen, all students are required to have a student visa for the duration of their exchange program.

KUFS will send a certificate of Eligibility (COE) and an acceptance letter required for the visa application.

These documents will be sent by email.

### **National Health Insurance**

All international students residing in Japan for over 3 months are required to enroll in the Japanese Health Insurance.

Those students holding the Student Visa are required to pay approx. 18,000 yen per year.

#### **Accommodations**

#### KUFS-Owned Residence

KUFS has four student residence managed by the KUFS Housing Support. The KUFS Housing Support will arrange accommodations on a first-come, first-serve basis. Rent must be paid per semester (min. 378,000 yen~ max. 450,000 yen).

The first rent payment (for the 1st semester) is due before coming to Japan, and the second rent payment (for the 2nd semester) is due before the second semester begins. The details will be sent to you from the Housing Support after you have completed the application procedures.

## **Cost of Living**
