### Course Description:

FLDEDUC 5212A helps facilitate formational ministry leadership through theological reflection on applied learning in a field placement. It includes: 1. placed-based contextual relevancy; 2. praxis-based experiential learning; 3. racial sensitivity training, along with Indigenous and environmental ministry awareness training; and 4. intentional spiritual formation that permeates all aspects of the individual's life and service in the world.

2. Ability to analyze a diverse social and intercultural context of ministry and adapt behaviour and formulate strategies to acknowledge cultural differences and recognize commonality
