READY TO TAKE ACTION? 3 STEPS TO CHANGE STUDENTS' LIVES

Huron's Advancement Team looks forward to collaborating with you to discuss a donation that reflects your giving priorities and the value you place on creating opportunities for current and future Huron students.

CHOOSE THE TYPE OF AWARD

- Bursary: based primarily on demonstrated financial need
- Scholarship: based on academic achievement or excellence in a particular program
- Award: based on a combination of academic and non-academic criteria
- Beyond the classroom: residence bursaries, experiential learning awards, or internship funding



CONSIDER ANY ADDITIONAL CRITERIA

Will the award be for incoming first-year or upper-year students? Will it be offered as a one-time or continuing (renewable) award? Where possible, will the award support students in a particular program or field of study?



REVIEW THE FUNDING OPTIONS

- For an immediate and meaningful impact, fund a new named award (requires a minimum gift of \$2,500/year for five years of offering the award)
- Establish an endowed fund to support an annual award in perpetuity (suggested gift of \$50,000 to generate \$2,000 annually; this can be pledged over a period of up to five years)
- Legacy gifts designate funds in your will or estate plans to establish a new award or provide continuing support for an existing award

WAYS TO GIVE

Gifts can be made by cheque, credit card, and through a variety of other channels. Gifts of publicly traded securities (stocks, bonds, mutual funds, etc.) may also provide additional tax advantages and allow you to provide students with a greater level of support than you may have thought possible.
